Minimum GPA for application is 2.5

Completion of a high school level Chemistry course with a minimum "C" grade within ten years of admission to the program

\*Physical Assessment, NSG137 is taken at Capital Health School of Nursing in May/June prior to fall admission.

Preferences given to applicants that have all non-nursing courses completed

LPN application must be postmarked by February 28<sup>th</sup>.

♦ **NOTE: Science and Math courses must be less than 10 years old at the time of enrollment in the School of Nursing.**

LPN applicant must have current licensure as an LPN and one-year clinical experience (acute care, sub-acute, long-term or rehab areas.)
